Naturalist Steve Hale from Open World Explorers will give a one-hour presentation on area birds, which will include images and bird calls that assist with bird identification.

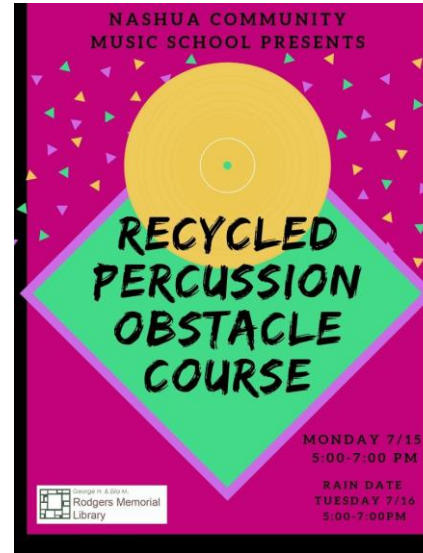
