**The following are just some of the
business aids offered by the
George H and Ella M. Rodgers
Memorial Library.**

Copiers: Photocopies are available for .10 cents a page for black and white and .25 cents a page for color.

Fax: A fax machine is available for patrons to use; it is located next to the copier. For faxes within the US, Canada, or Caribbean, the first page is \$1.50, and each additional page is \$1.00. For international faxes the first page is \$4.95, and each additional page is \$3.45. The machine accepts most debit and credit cards, though cash cards may be purchased for those who wish to pay with cash.

Computers: The library provides public access computers. They may be used up to one hour per day. Time extensions can be given at the discretion of the staff if no one is waiting. Printouts are 10 cents per page for black and white, 25 cents per page for color. See the computers and internet policy for additional information.

Free Notary Service: The library has staff members who are notaries. They are available most days 9-5 and some evenings and weekends. Call the library to find out when the notary is available.
