The library gardens are once again in bloom and we are looking for people interested in keeping them healthy and beautiful. We also plan to have some gardening related programs and discussions.



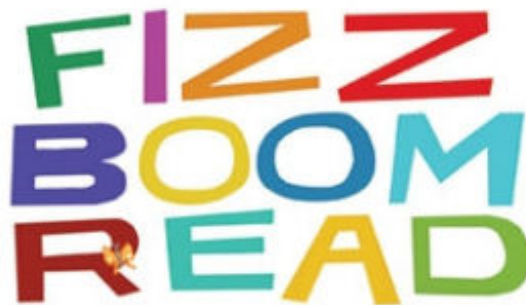

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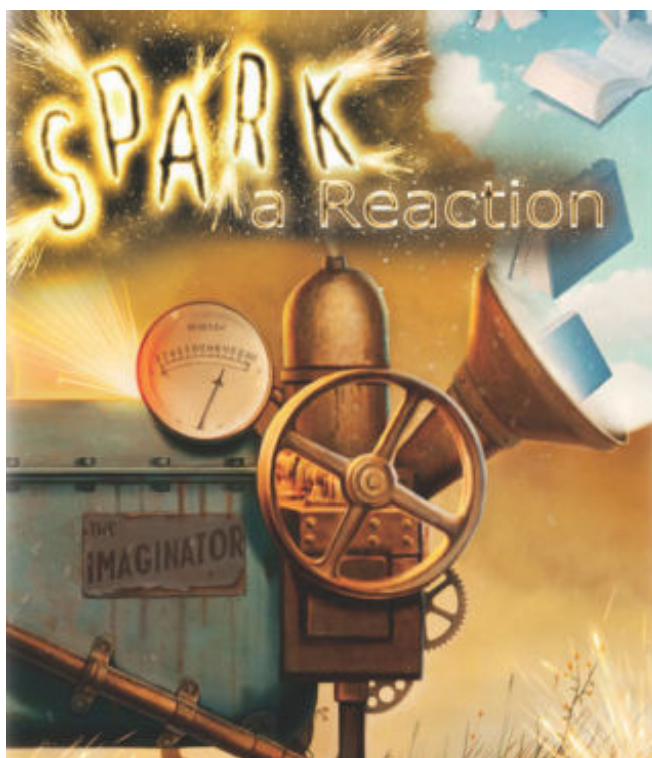
### Teen Summer Reading Earn Badges, Win Prizes!
